

Garbage

Collected weekly

Recycling

- Collected every other week
- 95-gallon cart (yellow lid)

Yard Waste

- Collected weekly
- Materials Accepted: Must be completely natural and vegetative.
- NO manufactured wood material, such as plywood and NO treated or painted wood, such as fencing or landscape timbers.
- Five (5) cubic yard limit per week roughly 30, 32-gallon garbage bags.
- Limbs, logs and stumps must be five (5) feet or less in length and less than six (6) inches in diameter.
- No single item or container can weigh more than forty (40) lb.

Bulk Waste

- Collected weekly with your garbage.
- Materials Accepted: Objects too big for the garbage cart, e.g., toilets, sinks, mattresses, carpet, and fencing.
- Weight Limit: Safe for two people to lift.

Appliances & Tires

- Must be scheduled in advance by calling (904)630-CITY (2489) or online at MyJax.CustHelp.com.
- Appliance doors must be securely closed or detached, with food and materials removed.
- Tire collection is limited to four (4) standard vehicle tires, with or without rims.

Prepare for Pick-up

Set Out Time: 6:00 AM


Weight Limits: Bags/cans CANNOT exceed forty [40] lb. each.

Instructions Garbage, yard waste, and recycling **MUST** be kept separate. Garbage should be bagged & tied, and placed within carts or cans. Excess bags and oversized items may be neatly placed alongside for collection.

Garbage will NOT be collected from recycling carts.

Do NOT put recycling in plastic bags. If the recycling cart is overfilled, please save excess items for the next recycling collection day.

Recyclable materials contaminated with garbage or other non-recyclables will **NOT** be collected.



Placement: Cans, carts, and items set out for collection must be visible, accessible, and placed WITHIN three (3) feet of the curb/edge of pavement. and AT LEAST three (3) feet away from obstructions such as vehicles, mailboxes, fire hydrants, and utilities.

RECYCLING CART

Materials Accepted: Plastics (#s 1, 2, 3, 5, and 7); steel food containers, aluminum cans and bakeware; mixed paper (such as newspaper, magazines, junk mail, office paper—NO shredded paper); drink cartons; fiberboard and flattened cardboard (2 ft x 3 ft or smaller); and green, brown, or clear glass bottles and jars (without lids).

Instructions: items should be clean, empty, and dry. **Do NOT put recycling** in plastic bags. Keep paper items together by putting into paper bags or empty fiberboard/cardboard boxes.

ONLY these items should be in your recycling cart:







MIXED PAPER

*NO Shredded paper

CARDBOARD (Flattened)

FIBERBOARD & CARTONS







PLASTIC # 1, 2, 3, 5, & 7

* NOT Accepted: #4, #6, & black plastics

STEEL & ALUMINUM CANS

CLEAR, BROWN, OR GREEN GLASS

NOT ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING

#4 Plastics (LDPE) including cling wrap, grocery bags, and garbage bags.

#6 Plastics (polystyrene) like Styrofoam, take-out food containers, packing peanuts, and plastic cutlery,

Soiled or Food-contaminated Items for example, fast food boxes, greasy pizza boxes or peanut butter still left in the jar.

Biological/Medical Waste, Needles.

Weapons

Hazardous Materials OR Their

Containers: this includes batteries, paint, aerosol cans, fireworks, flares, and chemicals of any kind

Electronics Waste like cables, wires, TVs, computers, cell phones, fluorescent light bulbs

Rubber

Shredded Paper

Colored Glass (unless brown or green)
