

Commonly Acceptable Large Items:

- Bicycles
- BBQ Grills
- Vanity Base
- Vanity Top
- Cabinets
- Carpet (Rolled into strips no wider than 4 feet)
- Sofas
- Sectionals
- Mattresses
- Box Springs

- Tables
- Chairs
- Stoves
- Washers
- Dryers
- Freezers (with doors removed)
- Refrigerators (with doors removed)
- Dishwashers
- Water heaters (drained)

- Televisions
- Doors (cut in half)
- Glass (shower doors, windows, mirrors, etc... all must be duct-taped with a large "*" (asterisk) pattern for the safety of the collection team

Unacceptable Items and material:

- Biohazardous and Biomedical waste or containers that held biohazardous or biomedical waste
- Oil, Grease, Liquids, Liquid Paint, Sludge
- Tires
- RV, UTV, automobile, motorcycle, boat, or trailer parts
- Combustion Engines
- Batteries
- Fertilizers, Pesticides, Herbicides, or Soil

Any material that is not properly contained, bundled, packaged, or is too large/heavy for two people to lift and move will not be collected.
