Collection Schedule & How-To Guide

OVERVIEW

Trash

See Section II: Trash for full guidelines.

- Collected weekly.
- 95-gallon Meridian Waste cart.
- All materials must be **INSIDE** the cart other than three additional bags of trash may be placed neatly beside the carts for collection.
- To help containerize litter, please bag waste before placing it in the cart.

Recycling

See Section II: Recycling for full guidelines.

- Collected weekly.
- 65-gallon Meridian Waste cart.
- All acceptable recyclable materials are collected in a single cart.
- ONLY the contents WITHIN the recycling cart are collected; no materials left outside the cart will be collected.
- Glass, plastic bags, plastic films and construction materials are NOT acceptable.
- Do NOT bag recyclable materials.

Yard Waste

- Collected weekly. You can also schedule "By-Appointment" pick-ups with the City of Wentzville at (636) 327-5101.
- 95-gallon Meridian Waste cart or customer-provided * cart (*See full guidelines for size options), tied bundles, and paper lawn/leaf bags.

PREPARE FOR PICK-UP

Collection Day: To look up your specific collection days, please visit WentzvilleMO.gov/MyDay or call the City of Wentzville.


Set Out Time: Place carts curbside the night before or no later than 6:00 AM on your collection day.

Materials: Please refer to full guidelines in SECTION II.

Weight Limits: Carts CANNOT exceed 60 lb. each. Individual trash bags cannot exceed 40 lb.

CART PLACEMENT

Carts MUST be WITHIN three (3) ft. of the curb and MUST be AT **LEAST three (3) ft. away** from any standing object (this includes mailboxes, vehicles, and other waste containers).



HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

If the holiday falls on or prior to your regular collection day, pick-up will be delayed by one day through the end of that week.

If the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the collection schedule will **NOT** be affected.

SPECIAL ACCOMMODATIONS FOR COLLECTION SERVICES

Our solid waste contractor offers Special Accommodations for Collection Services when all adults at an address have special needs or disabilities that prevent them from setting their trash cart/bags or recycling carts at the curb for collection.

If a request for an **Accommodation for Collection Services** is approved by the City, Meridian Waste will collect the cart/bags at or near the garage door or front door of the home at no additional charge to the resident.

As part of this special service, a smaller 35-gallon size cart may also be made available.

Meridian Waste performs this special collection on the same day that curbside collection is provided on that street.

Guidelines By Waste Type

APPROVED Trash Waste

- YES Non-hazardous municipal solid waste
- **YES** Food scraps and food packaging
- YES Disposables
- YES Clothing
- YES Bottles, cans, newspapers & magazines
- YES Glass

NOT ACCEPTABLE In Your Trash

- NO Tires
- NO Yard waste
- NO Construction Materials
- NO White goods (e.g. home appliances like stoves and refrigerators)
- NO Hazardous Materials: Including but not limited to: batteries; automotive fluids (fuel, antifreeze, oils); paint and paint lacquer, stains, thinners, varnish and polishes; wood preservatives; and chemicals of any kind (i.e. pool chemicals, cleaners, solvents, adhesives; pesticides and weed killer)
- NO Empty Hazardous Material Containers
- **NO** Radioactive Materials
- NO Biological/Medical Waste
- NO Electronic Waste: Including but not limited to: televisions, computers, monitors, printers, VCRs, cell phones, telephones, radios and microwave ovens
- NO Liquids or Water-Soluble Solids
- NO Salt, borax, lye, caustics/acids
- NO Septic Tank or Chemical Toilet Waste
- NO Fluorescent Light Tubes and Ballasts
- NO Automobile Bodies

TRASH

Collection Schedule: Picked up **once weekly.** (Option of twice per week for additional fee.)

Collection Day: To look up your specific collection days, please visit WentzvilleMO.gov/MyDay or call the City of Wentzville.

Set Out Time: Place carts curbside the **night before** or no later than **6:00 AM** on your collection day.

Materials Accepted: Non-hazardous municipal solid waste. **NO** construction materials permitted.

Containers: 95-gallon Meridian Waste cart as well as up to three (3) customer-provided trash bags. **NO PRIVATE CONTAINERS** (including cardboard boxes) will be serviced/ collected.

Additional Carts: Extra 95-gallon carts will be provided for an additional monthly fee. Using an extra cart helps you avoid add-on per-bag trash fees if you exceed your weekly limit, plus keeps your property cleaner since bagged waste placed on the ground might be damaged and spill.

Proper Containerization: All materials **MUST** be securely bagged and either placed inside the cart (the cart lid must fully close) or set neatly alongside. Extra carts for large quantities of trash are highly encouraged versus bagged waste.

WEIGHT AND QUANTITY LIMITS

Weight: Carts CANNOT exceed 60 lb. each. Individual trash bags CANNOT exceed 40 lb.

Quantity: Each week, residents are permitted one full cart (no overflow; lid must fully shut) of securely-bagged trash and up to three (3) additional bags, if needed, to be placed next to the cart. After the first 3, there is an additional charge per bag.

Hazardous waste will NOT be collected.

Section II Guidelines By Waste Type

RECYCLING

Collection Schedule: Picked up once weekly

Collection Day: To look up your specific collection day, please visit **WentzvilleMO.gov/MyDay** or call the City of Wentzville.

Container: 65-gallon Meridian Waste cart.

Do NOT bag recyclable materials.

Materials Accepted: Plastics labeled #s 1, 2, 3, 5, and 7; aluminum, tin, and steel cans; corrugated cardboard (flattened); and mixed paper. Glass, plastic bags, plastic films, and construction materials are **NOT** acceptable in recycling.

Instructions: ITEMS MUST BE CLEAN, with non-paper items rinsed and labels removed.

Proper Containerization: Recycling in Wentzville is curbside single stream, meaning all acceptable recyclable materials are collected in a single cart. **ONLY** the contents **WITHIN** the recycling cart are collected; **NO** items left outside the cart will be collected.

NOT ACCEPTED in Recycling Cart: Glass, Plastic Bags, Plastic Films, and Construction Materials

Glass, plastic bags, and plastic films (such as cling wrap and plastic seals and sheets in packaging) are **NOT ACCEPTED** in the curbside recycling program due to the fact they cannot be separated out again and contaminate the processing of other recyclables, unfortunately rendering the entire batch unusable.

Your cart should contain **ONLY** these recyclables:

Items **MUST** be clean!

YARD WASTE

TWO COLLECTION OPTIONS:

- Standard 10-month Minimum Charge Program
- By Appointment

STANDARD 10-MONTH MINIMUM CHARGE PROGRAM

Collection Schedule: Picked up once weekly.

Collection Day: To look up your specific collection day, please visit **WentzvilleMO.gov/MyDay** or call the City of Wentzville.

Container: 95-gallon Meridian Waste cart, customerprovided cart (Must match requirements listed on this page.) and customer-provided paper lawn/leaf bags.

Materials Accepted: Leaves, grass, limbs, and branches (securely bundled with twine) **LESS THAN** six (6) inches in diameter and **LESS THAN** five (5) feet in length. Bundles should be less than 18 inches in diameter and **MUST NOT** weigh more than 50 lb.

Proper Containerization: All yard waste materials MUST be contained WITHIN the Meridian Waste cart, the customer-provided cart, in paper lawn/leaf bags, or secured in bundles with twine. No overflowing carts—cart lids must be fully closed.

What's Included: A combined total of fourteen [14] lawn/leaf bags or yard waste bundles, as well as the contents of one cart [lid must fully shut]. Each additional bag/bundle is an additional charge.

COLLECTION BY APPOINTMENT

Arrangements can also be made to collect Yard Waste by appointment. Contact the City of Wentzville at (636) 327-5101 for details and to schedule. Refer to guidelines listed above for detailed rules and instructions on materials, size & weight limits, and containerization.

Requirements for Customer-Provided Yard Waste Carts

If you'd like an extra cart for yard waste, you may either buy your own cart or rent a 95-gal cart from the City of Wentzville. Carts **MUST** match the dimensions and specifications below **to ensure the safety of the service providers** –**NO DEVIATIONS** will be allowed.

Cart MUST BE:

95 gallon capacity with dimensions of: **28.25 in. (W) x 44.5 in. (H) x 34 in. (D)**

or

65 gallon capacity with dimensions of: 24.25 in. (W) x 41.75 in. (H) x 31.75 in. (D)

Cart MUST HAVE:

- Tight-closing hinged lid
- Push/pull grab handle
- Two-wheeled solid axle
- Upper cart grab lipLower cart grab bar



Section II Guidelines By Waste Type

LARGE ITEMS AND WHITE GOODS/APPLIANCES

Collection Arrangements: Collection of **ALL** large items and white goods/appliances **MUST be scheduled in advance** with the City of Wentzville. For more information and to schedule a pick-up, call the City of Wentzville at **(636) 327-5101**.

Many times, large items are more efficiently handled with a construction dumpster. See Section III. Dumpster/Roll-Off Container Rental.

IMPORTANT: Any material that is not properly contained, bundled, packaged, or is too large/heavy for two people to lift and move will **NOT BE COLLECTED**.

QUANTITY AND WEIGHT LIMITS:

Quantities: Residents are permitted up to three (3) items collected at no additional charge per quarter, to be picked up on your regular service day.

Weight Limit: Safe for two people to lift.

Commonly ACCEPTABLE Large Items

Popular Large Items: Bicycles, BBQ grills, cabinets, vanity tops and bases, carpet (rolled into strips no wider than 4 feet), sofas, sectionals, mattresses, box springs, tables, chairs, other miscellaneous furniture, televisions, doors (cut in half), sheet glass such as shower doors, windows, mirrors, etc. (MUST be duct-taped across its full surface with strips making a large asterisk pattern strips going corner to corner, side to side, and top to bottom)

White Goods/Appliances: Stoves, washers, dryers, freezers (with doors removed), refrigerators (with doors removed), dishwashers, water heaters (drained)

UNACCEPTABLE Items and Materials

- NO Tires
- NO Oil, Grease, Liquids, Liquid Paint, Sludge
- NO RV, UTV, automobile, motorcycle, boat, or trailer parts
- **NO** Combustion Engines
- NO Hazardous materials or empty hazardous material containers
- NO Biohazardous/biomedical materials or empty containers that held biohazardous or biomedical waste
- NO Radioactive materials
- NO Fertilizers, Pesticides, Herbicides, or Soil


