Collection Guidelines

Prepare for Pickup

Collection Day: 2x per week (either Monday & Thursday or Tuesday & Friday). Your collection days are listed on your cart lid.

Set Out Time: Carts must be **placed curbside the night before or by 6:30 AM** on your collection day to ensure service.

Materials: All waste materials must be **BAGGED** to limit trash spillage during collection and contained INSIDE your 65-gallon cart. If your cart is full, additional tied bags (35 lb. or less) can be placed beside the cart. If you regularly have excess bags, extra carts are available for purchase (contact Customer Care for details).

Holiday Schedule

If the holiday falls on or prior to your regular collection day, pick-up will be delayed by one day through the end of that week. **Holidays Observed:** New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day (July 4th), Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

Cart Placement

Carts MUST be **LESS THAN five (5) ft.** from the curb and MUST be **AT LEAST five (5) ft.** away from any nearby standing objects (this includes mailboxes, vehicles, and other waste containers). The cart handle should point into the road, ready to be pulled toward the truck during collection.





HAZARDOUS WASTE is NOT PERMITTED

Garbage

- Collected twice per week (either Mon/Thur or Tues/Fri)
- 65-gallon Meridian Waste/ADSI cart
- Materials Accepted: Containerized, nonhazardous municipal solid waste.

Recycling

- Collected Wednesdays
- 65-gallon Meridian Waste/ADSI cart
- Materials Accepted: Acceptable recyclables include office paper, old newspapers, magazines, junk mail, old telephone books, paper sacks, catalogues, brown paper cartons (cereal and cracker boxes), corrugated containers, aluminum and steel cans, plastic bottles and jugs (#1 PET and #2 HDPE only).

Yard Waste

- Collected weekly on your normal collection day
- Quantity Limits: Up to 2 cubic yards of yard waste collected weekly, and up to 8 cubic yards every other week collected by grapple truck, including limbs cut in lengths of no more than 6 feet and less than 8 inches in diameter.

Bulky Waste Collection

- Monday & Thursday Customers: The1st & 3rd weeks of each month.
- Tuesday & Friday Customers: The 2nd & 4th weeks of each month.
- Materials Accepted: Items too large to fit in the cart, such as furniture and household fixtures. White goods, as well as noncontractor generated construction debris, also collected via construction grade bags (limit 4 bags per collection).

NO — Electronic Waste: Including but not limited to: televisions, computers, monitors, printers, VCRs, cell phones, telephones, radios and microwave ovens

NO - Liquids or Water-Soluble Solids

NO - Salt, borax, lye, caustics/acids

NO - Septic Tank or Chemical Toilet Waste

NO - Fluorescent Light Tubes and Ballasts

NO - Automobile Bodies

The following are accepted for curbside recycling: plastic #1 (PET) and #2 (HDPE); aluminum and steel cans; newspaper, magazines, junk mail, office paper, paper shopping bags, tissue or cereal boxes, and other clean cardboards.

NOTE: Items must be clean, with non-paper items rinsed and labels removed.
